**Math Composition Books:** Students are required to maintain a math notebook with class handouts, graded papers, homework assignments, and a table of contents. A running table of contents will be left on the board listing the required materials and assignments. Students should keep their table of contents and materials in order in their notebooks at all times. Notebooks will be evaluated twice during the grading period.

## Guidelines for Composition Books

- Have them with you in class every day!!!
- Update your table of contents every day! If you are absent catch it up when you return to school.
  - Number every page.
- Write a date on each item on the table of contents or on each page.
- GLUE everything in when you get it or when you are asked to. Never just fold it and stick it in the composition book.
- Let the glue dry good or wipe off excess before you close your composition book...pages will stick together.
  - SHOW ALL graded work to a parent. Show your parents your composition book at least once a week.
- Be neat! Take care of your composition book. It is a reflection of you and your work



## Classroom Expectations

- Respect each class member's right to learn and the teacher's right to teach. That means NO TALKING during instruction time without permission.

IF A STUDENT HAS AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE FROM CLASS OR IS ASSIGNED AN OUT-OF-SCHOOL SUSPENSION, THE STUDENT CAN MAKE UP WORK FOR HALF CREDIT THROUGH ARRANGEMENTS MADE BY THE STUDENT AT HIS OR HER INITIATIVE. STUDENTS MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS WITHIN THREE DAYS OF THE ABSENCE. IF THE STUDENT FAILS TO COMPLETE THE WORK ACCORDING TO THE ARRANGEMENTS MADE, HE OR SHE WILL RECEIVE ZEROS ON THE MISSED ASSIGNMENTS AND TESTS.
